CIVIS PROGRAM

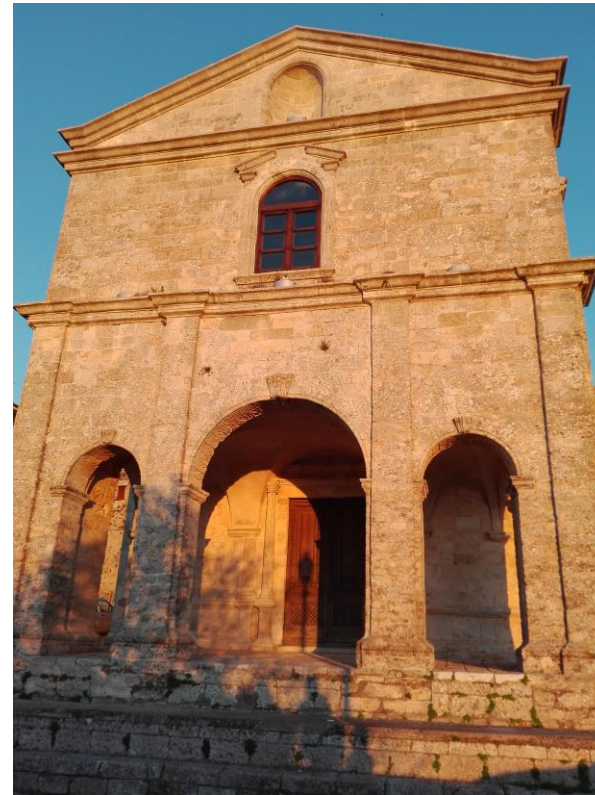
The CIVIS program is an initiative that promotes "quality pilot projects" aimed at the recovery of historical centers and aimed at cooperation networks of small urban centers, consisting of at least 5 Municipalities.

It was financed by the Autonomous Region of Sardinia through economic resources of POR Sardinia 2000-2006 - Axis V "Cities" - measure 5.1 "Policies for urban areas".



The project of Osilo: Land of monasteries, churches and monuments

- ▶ The project “Land of monasteries, churches and monuments” was led by the municipality of Osilo and included the municipalities of Florinas, Ploaghe, Cargeghe, Siligo, Banari and Muros;
- ▶ The main objectives of the project were to enhance historical religious buildings through their recovery and to intervene to improve historic centers.
- ▶ The total cost of the activities realized in Osilo was of € 405.000,00.



The actions of the Project

- ▶ The project proposal envisaged implementing an intervention that would enhance the attractors present in the Municipality of Osilo and in the partner municipalities, through the creation of a Document Center with archive and inter-municipal laboratory, dissemination center, cataloging and archive of religious artworks
- ▶ The center was born in the former market in the urban center, in a strategic position with respect to the tourist/religious routes that interest the Network Municipalities.



The actions of the Project/2

- ▶ For the recovery of the building materials and techniques of local tradition were used, thus contributing to the enhancement of the material knowledge of the area. All the works were carried out trying to have minimal impact on the environment
