# Municipality of Aksakovo European Youth Parlament

- Project initiator and coordinating city: Municipality of Guimarães (Portugal)
- Part of a strategy for the development and deepening of European multilateral relations
- Concept: European Intermunicipal Association (6 member cities + 2 partner cities) that is enhancing the promotion of a structured reflection on the themes included in the European political agenda and / or relevant issues in the national / local spectrum, fostering the bonds of friendship and fraternization among the participating youths / municipalities
- National round + international round (the host city is selected on rotation principle)



### Municipality of Vila Nova the Cerveira

- Project initiator and coordinating city: Municipality of Vila Nova de Cerveira
- The BRIDGE Project Building Relationships for a Democratic Goal for Europe is funded by the Europe for Citizens program. 11 cross-border organizations/municipalities from 10 countries came together with the aim of strengthening the feeling of solidarity between European members and neighboring countries, reinforcing the spirit of solidarity among citizens
- Concept: Based on this geographical reality, the consortium shares the same desire to promote cross-border citizenship and social cohesion across borders. This drive for cooperation is realized through addressing two of the main phenomena affecting the European Union: Euroscepticism and xenophobia.
- During the project's execution the partners will analyze the causes that fuel the widespread xenophobic feeling in many countries, presenting possible solutions to ensure that the European Union's cross-border regions can, through their own means, improve European citizenship.



# Municipality of Osilo

- Project initiator and coordinating city: Municipality of Osilo
- "Wear my shoes" project, to submit under the Erasmus Plus Program, KA1. It will involve 7 municipalities to be selected in the frame of the network "Open Towns"
- Concept: The project will consist of 6 days in which, through non-formal education activities, debates, role-playing and other activities, the pupils will see their empathic capacity strengthened, in order to respect everyone, without concern for gender, social, religious differences and so on. They will also learn how to avoid bullying and cyber-bullying.

- Objectives Nova Gorica and Gorizia as a one cross border European city; Green, lively city with a high quality of living; innovative city of entrepreneurial thinking
- Specific objective 1: establishment of a cross-border cultural ecosystem in both cities enhancement of a common participation of both cities in projects and European connections (Network of towns)
- Specific objective 2: encourage multicultural environment to raise the number of events which emphasize common aspects of European cultures, heritage and history; to raise the number of events which promote cultural diversity, dialogue and mutual unterstanding between European citizens.
